Mummy Dogs



These adorable mummy dogs are the perfect way to start your Halloween party. They're easy to make and always a hit with kids and adults alike.

Ingredients:

- 1 package (12) hot dogs

- 1 can (10 oz) refrigerated pizza dough
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- Mustard, for dipping

Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).
2. Unroll the pizza dough and cut into 12 strips.
3. Wrap each hot dog with a strip of dough, leaving a small space at the top for the "face."
4. Brush the dough with olive oil and bake for 15-20 minutes, or until golden brown.
5. Use mustard to draw on eyes and a mouth.
6. Serve with your favorite dipping sauce.

Spider-Web Dip



This spooky dip is sure to be a hit at your Halloween party. It's made with a creamy sour cream base and topped with a spider-web design of black olives and sour cream.

Ingredients:

- 1 cup sour cream

- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup chopped green onions
- 1/4 cup chopped black olives
- 1/4 cup chopped sour cream

Instructions:

1. In a medium bowl, combine the sour cream, mayonnaise, and green onions.
2. Spread the mixture into a 9-inch pie plate.
3. Arrange the black olives in a spider-web design on top of the dip.
4. Use the sour cream to create a spider-web design around the olives.
5. Serve with your favorite dipping chips.

Witches' Broomsticks
